#### NOTICE TO ALL POST 694 LEGIONNAIRES

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO POST 694 BYLAWS:** Due to the lack of participation at Post 694 Executive Committee and General Membership meetings it is apparent that the Bylaws must be amended to decrease the quorum requirement at said meetings if the Post are to continue to function and conduct business. The following amendments are proposed for member approval to insure that Post 694 remains active:

#### (1) Article VII Executive Committee now reads:

"Section 3 Executive Committee Meeting

Item (b) A quorum requires at least 8 officers."

With member approval <u>Article VII Executive Committee, Section 3 Executive Committee Meeting, Item (b)</u> will be amended to read: "A quorum requires at least 5 officers."

#### (2) Article IX General Membership Meeting now reads:

"Section 3 Quorum

A quorum shall require at least ten Members in Good standing to be present throughout the meeting..."

With member approval <u>Article IX General Membership Meeting, Section 3 Quorum</u> will be amended to read: "A quorum shall require at least five Members in Good Standing to be present throughout the entire meeting..."

A review of the Post 694 Bylaws and proposed changes will be held at the general membership meeting on November 10, 2016 at 7 PM. The second reading and vote for approval will occur at the general membership meeting on December 8, 2016 at 7 PM. Members attending these meetings will have the opportunity to provide input on this matter.
