Pay your 2016 dues NOW to avoid dues increase and avoid a gap in membership. This increase was a result of an increase to the per capita tax charged by the National American Legion.

At the General Membership Meeting in October, an increase in dues was approved by the General Membership. If you renew your membership prior to December 20th you can still pay the \$35 rate. We are encouraging all members to do this. If you fail to renew prior to December 20th you will need to pay the new membership rate of \$40.00.
